

Upper School Supplies for 2023-24

Refer to the basic supplies and summer assignment information on page 1 of this list. Every student in 9-12 needs to read that information.

Every student in 9-12 must have these basic supplies—

- Ear buds for iPad (for use in class only, not for the halls)
- A book cover for every book (Brown paper bags covers are preferred. Do not select self-adhesive book covers or contact paper.)
- White loose-leaf notebook paper for each notebook
- Dark blue or black ink pens
- #2 pencils with erasers (lead or mechanical)
- Stylus for iPad (student's choice of kind)
- Highlighters

iPad Apps. Some teachers may designate iPad Apps for students to use throughout the course of the year. Most of these apps will be free, and you should never be asked to purchase a required app on your own. Some teachers have listed specific iPad Apps in their supply lists, and students are expected to have those on their iPads.
