A few reminders...

First Day of School. Wednesday, August 7, is a required orientation day for students in grades 9–11 who are new to Harding. Seniors will be on their annual retreat.

The first regular day of school for all students in grades 9–12 will be on Thursday, August 8. It will be a B day.

Back to School Bash. All families are invited to the Back to School Bash on Friday, August 9 starting at 5:30 pm. Join us and eat from some of Memphis' best food trucks, purchase spirit wear, take pictures with friends in photo booths, and get pumped up with an all-school pep rally that begins at 7:00 pm.

Meet the Teacher Night. Mark your calendar for Meet the Teacher Night on Monday, August 19. This is a parents-only event designed to allow you to get to know the teachers

who are blessed to work with your child each day. We hope every student will have at least one parent in attendance. Mr. Williamson will open with a Family Meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium. Please make plans to attend.

Health records. The state of Tennessee requires that every student have a complete health record on file with the school from the beginning of the year. This year our school nurses are utilizing FACTS to maintain all medical and health records. Please check here for the instructions on how to enter and confirm this information in FACTS.

If your student's health records are from another state (for example, if you live in Mississippi or have moved from Texas), you must take your student's health form to a Tennessee physician or to one of the Memphis & Shelby County Health Department locations and have the data transferred to a Tennessee form.

All medical forms and records must be submitted before school begins. Beginning the first day of school, any child whose health records are not complete will not be allowed to attend classes.

Uniforms. Students are expected to wear uniforms from the very first day. The guidelines are posted online here. Please check to be sure uniform items still fit and are the appropriate length.

Student Handbook. In an effort to be as paperless as possible, we are posting the student handbook online again here. We will not be sending printed copies home. You and your student will also need to log into Final Forms and sign the handbook receipt form. If you do not have an account in Final Forms, you will need to set one up. Please go to hardingacademymemphis-tn.finalforms.com to set up your account. Click on New Account under the Parent logo. There is a video guide to help you. Once you have an account, please select your student's name to find the handbook receipt form. For any form in Final Forms that requires a parent and student signature, parents are required to sign before parents.

Cell Phone Policy. Beginning this school year, our middle and upper schools will be cell phone free. If you need a refresher on the details of the new cell phone policy, check out the FAQs <u>here</u>. Students are expected to abide by the new cell phone policy on the first day of school. If you haven't filled out this <u>form</u> or picked up your student's Yondr pouch, please do so before school begins. You can pick up your pouch 8:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m. on any of these dates: July 24—25, August 5—6.

iPads. Please be reminded of the policy governing the apps that students may have on their school iPads. Students may download only those apps that are on the authorized list, viewable at HardingLions.org/ApprovedApps. There are consequences for downloading unauthorized apps. Fobs. Student fobs will be reissued during the first week of school. Students need to be sure to have a lanyard upon which to clip it so that their fobs are not lost. Replacement fobs are \$10.
