Biography of Dee Eugene Bonner by Debbie Bonner Perkins

Dee Eugene Bonner was born September 23, 1929 in Centralia, Illinois. He won his first track medal in first grade at Washington Elementary School in Centralia. His love for weightlifting started in eighth grade with weights that he made out of concrete blocks. He played three sports at Centralia Township High School – football, basketball and track. In his senior year, the track team won the Illinois State Track Championship. Dee was on the winning relay team and earned medals in three other events.

He graduated from Arkansas State University in 1951, where he had an outstanding athletic career in football, basketball and track. Ironically, in a career that began without an athletic scholarship, he earned 11 varsity letters, a long-standing ASU record. In his senior year, he was named Most Outstanding Athlete. As well, his personality earned him the titles of Most Popular and Wittiest Student. As a member of the track team, he ran the high and intermediate hurdles and the 100 yard dash, high jumped and threw the shot put. He held the Arkansas State record in the shot put for more than 20 years. His favorite event was the high hurdles in which he won many medals.

From 1951 to 1957, Dee coached men's and women's high school sports in the boot heel of Missouri. At Holland High School, Dee coached their first state medalist in track. Training by running alongside Dee's car, Kenneth Childers won the 440-yard dash. The women's basketball team he coached in Holland was his first undefeated team. He also coached football, basketball and track for seven years at Charleston High School. He was the winningest coach in school history for all sports. His undefeated track teams won ten meets in Missouri, Kentucky and Arkansas, including the Missouri state track meet, with team members winning five first place medals.

Dee worked for the Prudential Insurance Company for thirty years, but his first love was sports. He used his athletic gifts as volunteer coach for Harding Academy and Bartlett High School, turning "physical wrecks" into state champions and boys into men. Dee began his volunteer coaching at Harding Academy in 1975, a relationship that lasted seventeen years. He assisted with the hurdles, field events, and weight training as well as some of the women's track events. In 1989, he began volunteering at Bartlett High School where he developed the weight training programs for the high school basketball teams. Dee loved working with the youngest, most undeveloped students who showed a real potential for excelling in a given event. He had a real talent for observing a young man and identifying exactly the event in which he could most effectively use his talents. He had a nickname for everyone...just ask the "physical wrecks."

In 1953, he married his wife of 52 years, Sue Davidson Bonner. Their children and grandchildren are Debbie and Mark Perkins and their son Conner of Memphis; Susan and Curt Patton and their children Luke, Timothy and Elaina of Forrest City, AR; Dee Anna and Hubie Smith and their children Adam, Rachel and Rebecca of Nashville, TN. In 1992, he was diagnosed with cancer. In God's perfect timing, he died on February 13, 2006....the opening day of the track season.
