GENERAL SUPPLIES FOR ALL CLASSES:

Spanish

- Instrument (chosen after school starts)
- Concert attire: white button down long-sleeved shirt, khaki pants, black socks, black shoes (heels and toes covered)
- Band fee \$125 (will collect when school begins) - includes maintenance and repair on school-owned instruments, method books & rhythm books, reeds, valve oil, slide oil,

drum heads, drum sticks, music, All West and WTSBOA audition and festival fees, band t-shirt, student band banquet ticket

Middle School Chorus

- Middle School Chorus Folder & Pencil (will be issued on the first day of class)
- Concert Attire
 - Parents are responsible for ordering attire
 - Instructions for ordering will be shared in August
 - Girls' Attire | White dress shirt, circular skirt and black flats
 - Boys' Attire | White dress shirt, black dress pants, black socks, and black dress shoes
 - If your student participated in Treble Chorus or MSC and can still fit their concert attire, they don't have to purchase the concert attire again. However, if your student is new to chorus or has outgrown their concert attire, they will need to purchase concert attire in August
- Chorus Fee of \$65 | Payment Due August 28th (covers supplies, chorus folder, banquet ticket, and chorus t-shirt) Fee will be added to your FACTS account
- Sheet Music (will be issued out at school and must be always stored in Chorus Folder)

Junior Concert Band

- Instrument
- Concert attire: to be ordered in August at school (girls - black uniform chorus dress, black shoes - heels and toes covered, flats only; boys - uniform tuxedo ensemble, black shoes - heels and toes covered)
- Band fee \$125 (will collect when school begins) - includes maintenance and repair on school-owned instruments, method books & rhythm books, reeds, valve oil, slide oil, drum heads, drum sticks, music, All West and WTSBOA audition and festival fees, band t-shirt, banquet ticket

MS Theatre

- \$50 fee- covers all required materials for the school year (Fee must be paid in full or applied to FACTS by Friday, August 28th)

Horticulture

- Oversized coverall or overalls
- Old shoes or leather boots (not galoshes)
- Leather gloves
- Safety glasses/goggles
